Volleyball:

Coaching Clinic at Lockport High School for Sunday, February 14th. Also wants a Kids Clinic for 3rd-5th Grade, 1.5-2 hours, 4 Sundays (January 24, 31st and February 21st, 28th). Consider asking high school students to help run it.

Needs 2 nets and volleyballs - go through "Don". Ok'd by Board.

Field Maintenance:

Field(s) are 90% done--Sports Field has been out--"looks great". Groomed the fields 1, 3, and 4, aligned bases, fixed home plate. "We" are though struggling to get SportsField to communicate in regards to the sprinkler system (problem addressed to Greaney, Board via email). We will have to keep trying and check on this.

SportsField updated certificate to Village.

Rodeghero spoke again with Circle Tractor -- might be cheaper than originally expected for tractor maintenance. Also cleaned up the Gators.
